

Lesson Plan Inset Training – Recycling

Aims: To broaden knowledge and experience in encouraging Recycling

Objectives: To learn a variety of appropriate techniques fit for the purpose of educating young children on how to work with reusable materials, with finished samples to take away

Recourses: Card – Tin foil – Waste Paper – Plastic bottles – Wire – Bottle Tops – Scrap wool /Fibres – Fabrics – Polystyrene - and any other waste materials available

Activities: During the morning session we will start with pulp - paper making using waste paper and off cuts. During the afternoon session you will have the opportunity to explore jewellery making - printing - weaving - and sculpture
